New Funding Announced

The Government of Canada announced that on June 4th, two streams of the EnAbling Accessibility Fund will open: 1) Mid-sized projects and 2) Youth Innovation.

The Mid-sized projects component provides contributions of up to \$1 million to support larger retrofit, renovation or construction projects in facilities that house programs and services that help increase social participation and labour market opportunities for persons with disabilities in Canada. The Youth Innovation component seeks to engage and challenge youth between 15 and 30 years of age, to volunteer and collaborate with local organizations in their communities to secure funding of up to \$10,000 for accessibility projects.

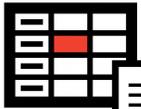
