

Early Learners Program

Overview

The Early Learners Program is a comprehensive ABA program, designed to help children gain foundational skills within a daycare-like setting. Using a naturalistic, play-based approach, the program aims to build skills to help children succeed in day-to-day activities in a structured environment such as daycare or school. The ELP program is facilitated by Board Certified Behaviour Analysts and Ontario Certified Teachers with a 3:1 ratio. The group has a maximum of 6 learners.

Programming

The program focuses on foundational skills such as communication (both vocal or using assistive technology/Picture exchange system), social skills and social communication, transitions, routines, following group directions and more. The program also exposes children to pre-academics (colours, shapes, numbers and letters). Additionally, toilet training, food pairing and using utensils may be targeted as a part of the child's individual programming.

Each learner will receive an individual learning plan, including 2 hours of 1:1 pull out services per month. Additionally, collaborations and detailed transition plans are included with the child's daycare or school team. We strongly value parent/caregiver input in order to ensure individual goals are meaningful for each learner.

Schedule

Full Circle Therapy offers the Early Learners Program 3 days a week on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:30-11:00, 9:00-11:30 or 9:30-11:30. Part-time options may be discussed with admin@fullcircleottawa.com.

Payment

The program cost is \$50/hour. Invoices are sent out via email on the 1st of the month and due within 7 days. Payment is due in full. Payment plans can be discussed with admin@fullcircleottawa.com.

Full Circle Therapy accepts Ontario Autism funding, including interim one time funding and child benefit. Insurance coverage must be confirmed by each individual provider.

Cancellations

Withdrawal from the program can be made at any time with 30 days written notice.
